Basic Disaster Supplies Kit

- Food and water for at least three days
 - 1 gallon of water per person per day
- Radio, flashlight, and extra batteries





Basic Disaster Supplies Kit

- First aid kit
- Hygiene items
- Matches
- Whistle
- Extra clothing





Basic Disaster Supplies Kit



- Kitchen accessories
- Copies of credit and ID cards
- Cash
- Special needs items



Maintaining the Disaster Supplies Kit

- Keep canned foods in a cool dry place
- Store food in tightly closed containers
- Change stored food and water every six months
- Review your kit and family needs at least once a year
- Keep items in one or two easy-to-carry containers



Maintaining the Disaster Supplies Kit

- Keep items in one or two easy-to-carry containers
 - Shelter in place
 - Evacuation
